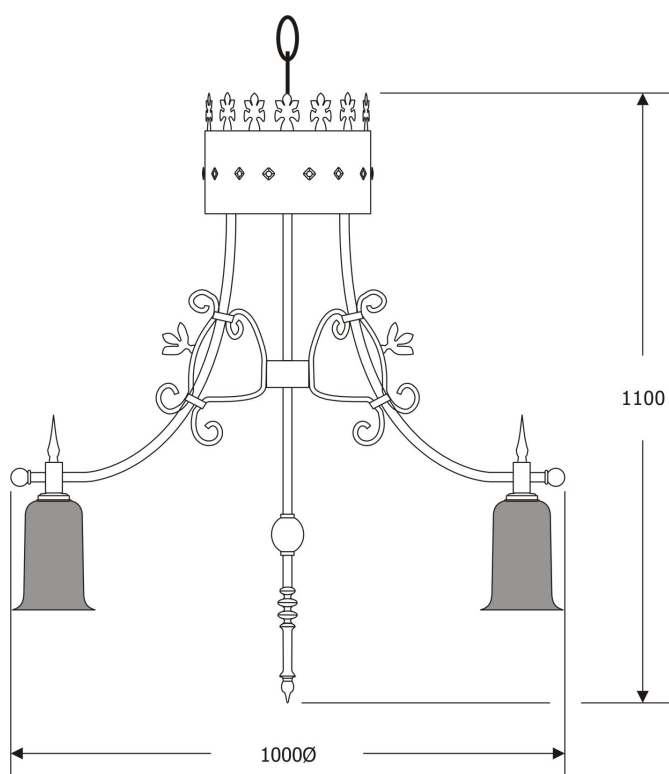


All Hallow's Church, Mitton



PROJECT: All Hallow's Church, Mitton

CLIENT: The Church of England

DESIGNER: Sunderland Peacock Architects

LAMPING: 5 x 75W single point halogen lamps

METAL FINISH: Satin black with gold highlights

SHADES: Opaque glass

DIAMETER: 1000 mm

HEIGHT: 1100 mm plus suspension

The new lighting scheme was required as a major part of the total refurbishment program to improve light levels and highlight original architectural features. The main bespoke chandeliers are made of wrought iron finished in black with gold highlights and feature halogen lamps with opaque bell glass shades, to give subtle illumination.

The "Celestial crown" sections at the top house high output dichroic lamps to illuminate the roof. Matching wall lights were manufactured using 150W halogen lamps to light up and down. In the crypt area, hidden halogen projector lamps were used to highlight the recumbent figures. The entire scheme is fully dimmable to accommodate different changes in ambience required for this multi-functional church.
